Some events with regard to JPIC in our Province.

1. **TREE PLANTING.** This is being demonstrated in various parishes and institutions by own individual confreres. like tree planting in Kayole and Soweto Parishes mid month of January 2010. also tree planting in Katani, Ruai, Simanjiro and Doldol.
2. **HIV/AIDS FREE TEST.** It is done in collaboration with Huduma ya Afya and many other groups carrying the same exercise. at the same time bringing awareness to the Christians.
3. **CIVIC EDUCATION.** The justice and peace **PARALEGAL** groups in Kayole and Soweto are going to various Small Christian Communities educating our Christians about the New Constitution review to be voted upon this year.
4. **STUDENTS AND JPIC.** After the WSF in Brazil i went to our formation houses giving them the highlights of the events. our formators educating them on the need to conserve water, electricity, planting trees and clean environment. Saturdays our students do manual or ground work in the parish or in the house.
5. **YOUTH DANCING GROUP.** It is a youth group with songs which advocate for justice and peace issues in the form of dance. for example during the VIVAT meeting in Nairobi. it entertained the gathering.
6. **LEGAL AWARENESS TO THE CHRISTIANS.** Some Christians do not know the legal proceedings and i do help them. family squabbles, legal proceedings eg the mother whose son was hit by police car and the lawyer wanted to get money from her.
7. **VIVAT WORKSHOP 11 - 15TH Jan 2010.** for East Africa, Egypt, Jordan= Middle East. possibility of setting up a VIVAT office in Nairobi. VIVAT NYK team attended.
8. **JPIC AND DEANERY.** Sometimes i am invited to facilitate meetings in our Nairobi Deanery at Parish level and to the youth.
9. **JAMBO NEWSLETTER.** I do write articles in our Provincial newsletter called Jambo with various issues about JPIC.
